The Liquor Control Commission hereby grants to the above-mentioned Club subject to the following terms, conditions and restrictions:—


A Permit authorizing persons over the age of 18 years to consume, possess or control liquor in the above-mentioned premises during such hours and on such day or days as are specified hereunder.

Mondays to Saturdays: 24 hours

Sundays: 12 noon to 2.30 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. to 6.30 p.m.

Subject to the provisions of the *Liquor Control Act 1968* this permit shall be in force from the 18th day of July, 19 69 until the 31st day of December, 19 69 both days inclusive.
